

#### Who is this course for?

The course is especially oriented but not limited to neurocritical care doctors, neurosurgeons, neurointensivists, neurologists, emergentologists, internal medicine specialists, cardiologists and nurses who work in critical care sectors.

## **Learning Objectives**

At the conclusion of the course, participants will be able to:

- Diagnose the most common acute neurological and neurosurgical pathologies;
- Generate a differential diagnosis suitable for neurocritical patients;
- Describe how to properly treat common acute neurological and neurosurgical diseases;
- Recognize how to use and properly prioritize limited resources for the treatment of these patients.
