Illinois' Maternal and Child Health Services Block Grant: Priorities, Strategies and National Performance Measures

The Title V Maternal and Child Health Block Grant Program is the nation's oldest federal-state partnership. It aims to improve the health and well-being of women, particularly mothers, and children. Andrea Palmer administers the State's Maternal and Child Health Services Block Grant programs, including the School Health program, Adolescent Health programming, Perinatal Regionalization and Infant Mortality Reduction efforts. Ms. Palmer is also responsible for implementing the State's Title V Action Plan, which includes the priorities, strategies, National and State Performance Measures for the MCH population.
