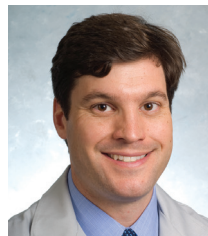

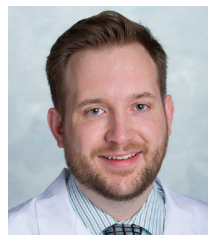
Objectives:

7. Discuss the Return of Results process for patients with actionable mutations as defined by the ACMG

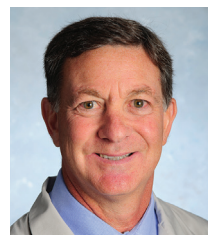
