



## OVERVIEW


Relapse and disease progression are the leading causes of treatment failure for most hematologic malignancies treated with both allogeneic and autologous hematopoietic stem cell transplantation (HSCT) and also CAR T cell therapy. Since the first symposium, now more than 10 years ago, we have witnessed tremendous progress in our understanding and treatment of relapse including the development of therapies specifically licensed to treat or prevent relapse post HSCT. The planned objectives of the 5th Workshop are designed to present the latest scientific and clinical advances related to relapse after HSCT and to provide a forum for the presentation of ongoing laboratory, translational, and clinical research specifically related to this field. The educational content of this conference is relevant for medical and pediatric hematologists-oncologists, translational and basic scientists, hematopathologists, physicians-in-training (Fellows/Residents/Post Docs), advance practice providers, pharmacists, oncology nurses and other associated allied health professionals. The Workshop will feature internationally recognized speakers from a multidisciplinary, diverse group comprised of basic and translational scientists and clinical investigators.

The workshop will include formal didactic presentations and informal discussion panels. It will also offer investigators interested in the field the opportunity to present their work in dedicated oral and poster sessions. As in previous years, the four best abstracts will be selected for oral presentation in the meeting.


