**Objectives:**

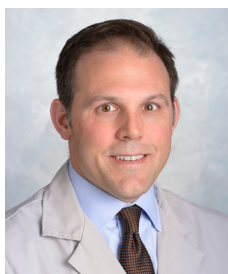
1. Identify pain generators of low back pain and lumbosacral radiculopathy
