KRANZLER CHICAGO REVIEW COURSE IN NEUROSURGERY



The **Chicago Review Course in Neurosurgery** has been recognized as the most thorough review of neurosurgery to residents and practicing physicians for more than forty years. Founded in 1973, this course was launched in an effort to provide a comprehensive and intensive review for residents preparing for their written boards, newly-established neurosurgeons preparing for their oral boards, and practicing neurosurgeons who want to ensure their diagnostic and surgical skills are current. The course is named to memorialize Dr. Leonard Kranzler's commitment to directing the course, and is hosted by Dr. Martin D. Herman and the University of Chicago. The week-long course has been updated to include interactive quiz questions to participants to supplement the rigorous and comprehensive lecture schedule offering neuroscience, critical care, neuro-anesthesia, neurology, neuro-ophthalmology, neuroradiology, neuro-oncology, pediatric neurosurgery, vascular neurosurgery, spine, and functional neurosurgery.
