KRANZLER CHICAGO REVIEW COURSE IN NEUROSURGERY

The **Chicago Review Course in Neurosurgery** is a comprehensive and intensive review of neurosurgery to residents who are preparing for the ABNS written boards. This course was launched fifty years ago by Chicago academic neurosurgery program chairmen and was recently named to memorialize Dr. Leonard Kranzler's commitment to directing the course. The course is hosted by Dr. Martin D. Herman and the University of Chicago.

The week-long course is available for in-person and virtual participation by United States and foreign residents preparing for their boards. **The first 20 residents who register in-person and who are part of an ACGME accredited program are entitled to 5 nights of free hotel at the Study Hotel adjacent to the Rubenstein Forum on the University of Chicago campus.**
